Frequently Asked Questions – FAQ on Paper and Demo Submissions

- **I am not sure if this work I have done is relevant to the conference – should I publish?**

The conference is aimed at industry experts in design, IP, verification, test, software and systems aspects. The topics cut across hardware, software and systems, given the rise of highly integration systems in today's products. There is high probability that you would be working in one of these key areas. Please feel free to check with organizing committee.

- **I am keen on patenting my work – can it be published?**

If your work is patentable then you should first apply for patent and then publish it as per patent laws (please check your applicable patent laws). It is ok to publish the work that has been patented but not published yet.

- **I think this may be proprietary information – can it be published?**

Please review with paper technical committee of your organization to ensure no proprietary information is published in external conferences.

- **This paper was published before – can I submit to this conference?**

Like any other IEEE conference, work submitted in paper should be original. However, if your present paper has additional and details over and above existing publication, then you can submit it. Please ensure that you do mention prior art in the paper and refer to original publication.

- **My work is on design/verification/test – but the tracks shown in the conference are at an industry domain level – can I submit?**

The conference will deal with various aspects of the product lines listed below. If your work is going to part in any of these product lines eventually, please go ahead and submit. Please select subdomains accordingly.

- **What should be length of paper**

The manuscript must be submitted in PDF format and must be set in IEEE Conference format and must be within a limit of 6 A4 sheets in double column format and 10-point.

FAQs for Demo Submissions

- **How can I submit my entry for Demo?**

Please follow the submission instructions on the WINTECHCON [webpage](#) and go through the registration formalities. Use the same “easy chair” link for submission.

- **Do I need to submit a paper or video for Demo?**

Please submit a presentation using the [template](#) in the webpage supporting your demo. A video recording of the demo is optional, but good to have. The video can be embedded or add link of the video. Make sure the link is accessible by external audience.

- **What facility will be provided for my demo ?**

The conference committee will provide the following items only to the demo presenter at the venue –

- a. Table , chair – 1 / 2 nos ,
- b. Power supply points - 2 /3 nos

You need to carry your own - Charger, Charging cables, any equipment, Spike buster, mouse, keypad, specifics of your demo. WINTECHCON will not provide any equipment or transport cost.

- **Will there be a fixed time slot for demos?**

Yes demos will be presented during a fixed period on the day of the conference. The selected participants will be notified as part of the Conference Agenda and timetable.

- **Will I have network connectivity at the venue?**

Yes, a guest network provision will be made available for all participants / speakers. we will not be able to guarantee the speed of the connection as it will be a guest network. Anything requiring high speed connection will need to make their own provision.

- **Will I be provided with a PC for my demo?**

No , the speaker / demo presenter need to make their own provision.

- **How many members can man the demo booth?**

5-6 members should be ok.

- **Is there any extra cost involved in case of Demo?**

Only the demo team needs to register and pay the registration fees, nothing else.

- **Are male team members allowed at the demo booth?**

Yes they are allowed, however the primary author / presenter should be a woman, they can assist in the demos. All accompanying male members too need to register and pay the fees.
